to us, He only takes the best.*

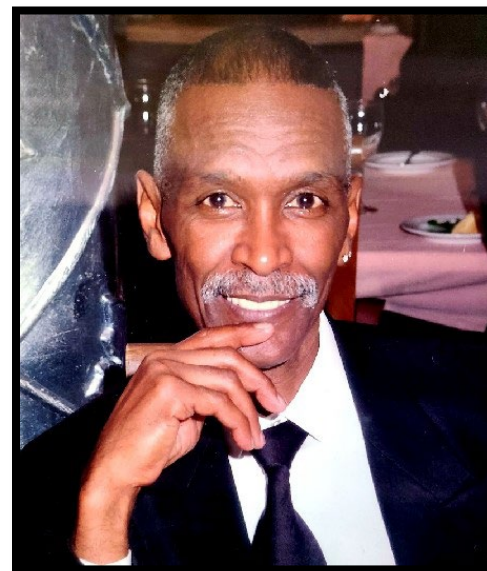
